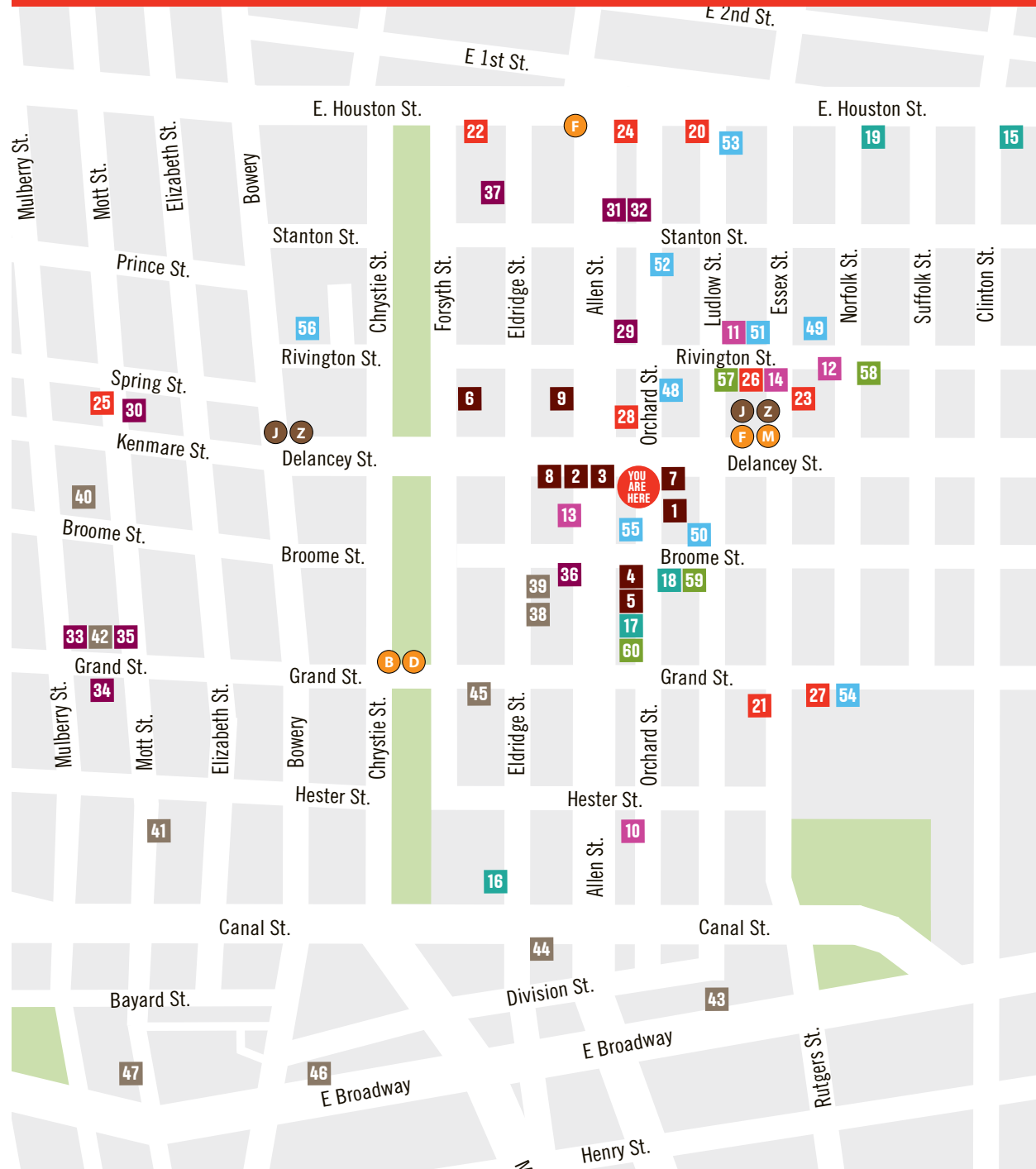

ESSEX STREET MARKET

The Essex Street Market opened in 1940 as part of an effort by New York City Mayor Fiorello H. LaGuardia to find a new place for street merchants to do business. The market's identity was shaped by the Lower East Side's Jewish and Italian immigrants, who came to the market not only to shop, but also to connect and share ideas.

Today, the market is known for its diversity – both in its food and its people – offering cuisine from across the world and attracting a racially and socio-economically diverse crowd from across New York City and beyond. The Market offers a range of products and services that include ethnic food markets, gourmet cheese and meat shops, coffee stands, art installations, and a barber shop.

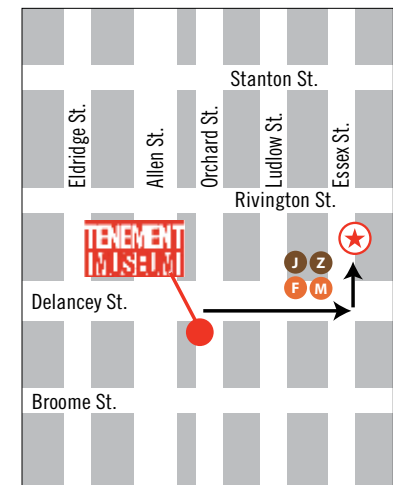
