What's a tenement?



Tenement: a building that is home to three or more families. This is **97 Orchard Street**, it has 20 apartments and is now a museum that tells the stories of immigrants who lived here from 1863-1935.

Where is 97 Orchard Street?



97 Orchard Street is in the **Lower East Side**, and you will visit this building as part of your trip to the Museum.

Who lived there?



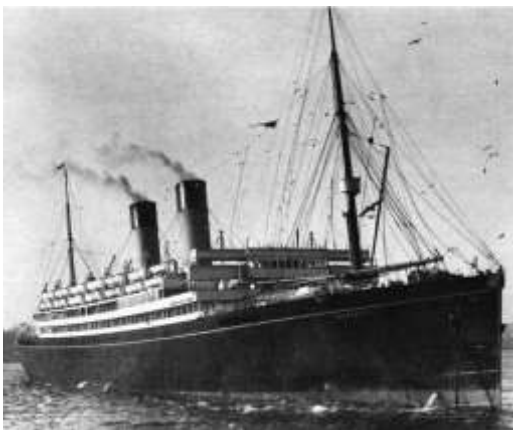
Confino Family: Victoria Confino and her family lived at 97 Orchard Street in the 1910s.

What will you do at the museum?



You will meet an actress playing the role of Victoria Confino in 1916, and you will visit in an apartment and ask her questions about her life.

Vocabulary words for your visit



Steamship: a large boat powered by steam. In the 1910s, immigrants traveled to the USA in boats like this.



Ellis Island: where immigrants went when they arrived in New York. It was open from 1892-1954.



Factory: a place where products are made.



Tradition: foods, holidays, etc., that have been part of a culture for a long time.



Compromise: to come to an agreement when people want different things.



Adapt: to change your behavior so it is easier to live in a place.



Sabbath: a Jewish holiday every Saturday, a day to rest and not work.
