



## **Protection in the United States**

## Electronic Dictionary



This is a picture of my father's family. It has my grandparents, two aunts, uncle, and my father (the young boy in the front). My grandparents were originally from Taishan in southern China, but moved to Hong Kong during World War II to escape the Japanese invasion of China.

In the 1970's, my great grandfather, who immigrated to New York, sent money for my grandfather to bring his family. My father, uncle, and aunts lived together in a small apartment on Allen St. in Chinatown with my great grandparents. The tenement was very small and all 4 children shared a tiny room. However, my grandparents remember this period of as one of the happiest times in their lives. My dad remembers how he listened to the Beatles, how his dad took him to Mets baseball games, and how the entire family went to the movies every Sunday for a **matinee**<sup>1</sup>. This is the first family photo they took in America, and it still sits on my grandma's night table.
